zu werden. Am 15. und 16. Sept. 1871 konnte ich
inmitten den ausgedehnten Nadelwäldern von
Houška, unter einem Himmel, den beinahe bis an
den Horizont tief ultramarin blau war, bei gering
gedeckten Sonnenscheibe das Licht der Aureola bei-
nahe bis an den Sonnenrand wortzagen, und sah ent-
schieden den aus den Photographien der Finsterniss
von 1870 bekannten trapezoidalen Umrisse der Co-
rona, wie dies auch Tacchini zu Palermo gelang."

I dare say the worthy P D S was quite right.
But surely the assertion which Prof Young makes (I
hope I am not detaining him too long - I like him so much)
that the light of the Corona "several times exceeds that of the
full Moon" - must be a slip. - If so, how can the
darkness in a total eclipse be so great as it is found
to be? -

You were so kind as to say you would let me see
Huggins's paper in the Viertelyährige. - I should
be very glad if quite convenient, to send return it in
a day or two. I hope you get "le Soleil" quite safe.
And I trust your dear Mother is quite recovered. Kindest
