Anne wife of Henry Saunders says. -
 Her husband and his sister Hannah Prosser
 say that Col. Powell (the witness & Executor) took
 the bill wth London & have it proved, and charged
 £10 for so doing, which was put down in one
 charge with the funeral expenses. - That 12
 months after death the family were assembled
 & the will read wth them by the Colonel Powell,
 the Rev. Tho^s. Powell being present, and the sur-
 plus of the money ~~left for~~ not left in the will but
 intended for proving the will, funeral expenses &c,
 was divided among them - perhaps 15s. apiece.
 There were Cottages in Clype which were sold,
 Anne Saunders believes to make up the money -
 and it was placed in Newford Old Bank, which
 failed. And the money had been put on land
 at Llanfair, Clifford, and was "rose" from that
 security to put on the Bages Farm.
